

Revelation Curriculum and Teaching Plan

1. January 10 - Introduction to Revelation
 - a. Introduction to the class, explain the way the class will work, pass out the syllabus, and explain some over arching concepts about the book of revelation, who wrote it, when, and where.
 - b. Look briefly at Dispensational, Covenantal, and Liberal perspectives on interpreting Revelation – explaining why and how we interpret Revelation
2. January 17 - Chapter 1 – What in the world is happening?
3. January 24 - Chapters 2 – Letters to the Seven Churches
4. January 31 - Chapter 3 – Letters to the Seven Churches
5. February 7 - Rapture – Comprehensive study on differing views
 - a. Pull together all scripture that speaks to the rapture and the first resurrection of the dead.
 - b. Explain the different perspectives of pre-trib, mid-trib, pre-wrath, post-trib
6. February 14 - Chapter 4 – God is still on the throne
7. February 21 - Chapter 5 – Worthy is the Lamb
8. February 28 - The Tribulation/Daniels 70th Week, Ezekiel and the Bones of Israel as a prophetic key
 - a. Breakdown what the tribulation is and where it is mentioned in the Bible.
 - b. Look deeper into Israel today to see how God’s preparation of Israel was predicted in Ezekiel to prepare for the tribulation period.
9. March 7- Chapter 6 – The Seal Judgments
10. March 14 - Chapter 7 – The 144,000 and the great multitude
11. March 21 – Chapters 8 & 9 – Seven Trumpet Judgments

 - a. Go over the Colossus and the Beasts that Daniel sees in his visions – explaining the gentile nations that are to come until the end of this age.
20. May 23 - Chapters 17 & 18 – The Fall of Mystery Babylon
21. May 30 - Judgment Seat of Christ – What we do now matters
 - a. In preparation for the Marriage Supper of the Lamb, we learn that our works done in the flesh will be judged by Christ.
 - b. Explain the significance of this in light of eternity.
22. June 6 - Chapter 19 – Marriage Supper, Triumphal Return, Armageddon
23. June 13 - Chapter 20 – Millennial kingdom established
24. June 20 - Hell, Great White Throne Judgment, and the Lake of Fire
 - a. What happens at the Great White Throne Judgment?
 - b. Where is hell? Where are the unrighteous people now that have already died? What is the Lake of Fire? Is it different then hell? Where is the bottomless pit?
25. June 27 - Chapter 21 & 22 – New Jerusalem, New Heaven, and New Earth
